

Terms of Use

Rules governing access to and use of the iTANZ corporate website, digital resources and investor-facing information.

Plain-language summary

Use the website lawfully, do not interfere with its operation, respect iTANZ and third-party intellectual property, and do not treat general website content as legal, investment or other professional advice. Specific contracts, statements of work and formal regulatory disclosures take priority over general website content.

1. Acceptance of These Terms

These Terms of Use ("Terms") govern your access to and use of websites and online content operated by or on behalf of iTANZ Technologies Limited ("iTANZ", "we", "us" or "our"). By accessing or using the website, you agree to be bound by these Terms. If you do not agree, please do not use the website.

Additional terms may apply to particular services, portals, events, downloads, recruitment activities, investor materials or contractual engagements. Where additional terms conflict with these Terms for a specific activity, the more specific terms will apply to that activity.
